Sapperton Village Hall

I was heartened to see that the Village Hall that was gifted to the village by my Great Grandmother in 1912 and designed by Ernest Barnsley is still extremely active, as indeed it was described as being in Norman Jewson's book published in 1951.

Sadly though I see as is so often the case, that the building is in need of urgent repairs and improvements; but it is though active and well supported, and from there must come hope. It is essential that the community of our villages is maintained and it is through gatherings such as those supported by the village halls that this occurs. Only last Thursday, I was talking to a lady whose young family had moved to the village of North Cerney and there the village community have gathered round to help them, something that they had never experienced before, having come from a large city background.

It is villages such as this and very much Sapperton, where there are still village schools and halls, which foster that community spirit and encourage an awareness of local people with their surroundings and neighbours which is so important. These halls play a vital role within the village and provide a resource where people can gather socially, or for other purposes, thereby maintaining and strengthening the sense of the village community so vital for their future.

The roles played by village halls has long been recognised by HRH The Prince of Wales and this one in particular requires all the support that it can be given and is something that I would very much second following my great grandmother's gift of the early 1900's.

I would be most grateful if you could keep me informed as to exactly what your plans are and what progress you have been able to make.






RE: SAPPERTON VILLAGE HALL
