Sapperton Village Hall Renovation

The Sapperton Village Hall is a unique Grade II listed building built in 1912 by Ernest Barnsley and Norman Jewson who were both key to the Arts and Crafts movement, instigated by the artist and writer William Morris (1834-1896) during the 1860s. Unfortunately 100 years on, it is in desperate need of a new roof covering and refurbishment of all windows to secure its long term future for now, and the next generations to come. The Sapperton Village Hall Trustees are embarking on a huge fund raising effort to raise the estimated £140,000 that will be needed for all works.

To enable us to proceed with national funding applications, (we are in the first stages of applying to over 25 separate funding bodies), we would like to raise an initial sum of £10,000 locally to ensure we are in a good position to apply for this external funding.

Any donations you give will go directly to this important renovation fund to protect this unique building.


